

Recycling Guidelines & Cart Placement

Proper Curbside Cart Placement:

- Recycling: (1) 95-gallon recycling cart (Black body/blue lid) or cart marked w/ "Recycle" sticker to be collected on recycling week
- Place carts at the curb (see picture) for collection prior to 7:00 am on service day
- To keep your curb clean and safe, Apex Waste strongly encourages getting all materials in the cart. Additional carts available upon request
- Recycling should be loose, unbagged
- Place carts at least 3' away from permanent structures (Ex: vehicles, mailboxes, light posts)
- Place cart with handles toward the curb.
- Self-owned carts must be ANSI compliant and work with automated tipping equipment (Example: Toter Brand at Lowes/Home Depot)
- Download our app or contact the office (303-841-7144) for questions regarding collection cycles or extra services.
- If recycling exceeds max limits, please contact the office at 303-841-7144 to schedule special pick-up for extras. Additional charges will apply.

Recycling Guidelines:

Curbside - Base Service Offering

- Recycling: (1) 95-gallon recycling cart (Black body/blue lid) collected every other week. Recycling in one cart with lid closed ensure material is highly recyclable at processing facility



Max Set-out at Curb (allowable)

- Recycling: If required, Apex Waste will pick-up additional 3-5 broken down boxes placed on side of cart or laid across the top of the cart (as pictured)
